## WE WELCOME SCHOOL, COLLEGE & UNIVERSITY GROUP VISITS TO SPACEX

Spacex is dedicated to supporting teachers and facilitating learning through contemporary art. We offer a range of different options for visits:

### TOURS

Guided tour of the exhibition with Spacex staff. Approximately 25 mins. Free.

### WORKSHOP TOURS

Exhibition tour followed by a short practical or discussion based workshop led by Spacex staff. Minimum of 1 hour. Free.

### INTERPRETATION WORKSHOPS

Tour and workshop designed to increase students' confidence in their own response to the exhibition and improve their critical skills. Minimum 1.5 hours. A charge may apply.

### ARTIST-LED WORKSHOPS

Full or half day practical workshops led by an artist educator. Session times and charges vary and can sometimes be subsidised. Fee: £80 half day session £160 full day session.

**Please note** that a workshop or tour may not be available on your chosen dates. If led sessions are not available, you are more than welcome to carry out a self-directed tour on your chosen date and use dry art materials in the gallery. Some equipment is available to borrow from the gallery free of charge.

## ARRANGING YOUR VISIT

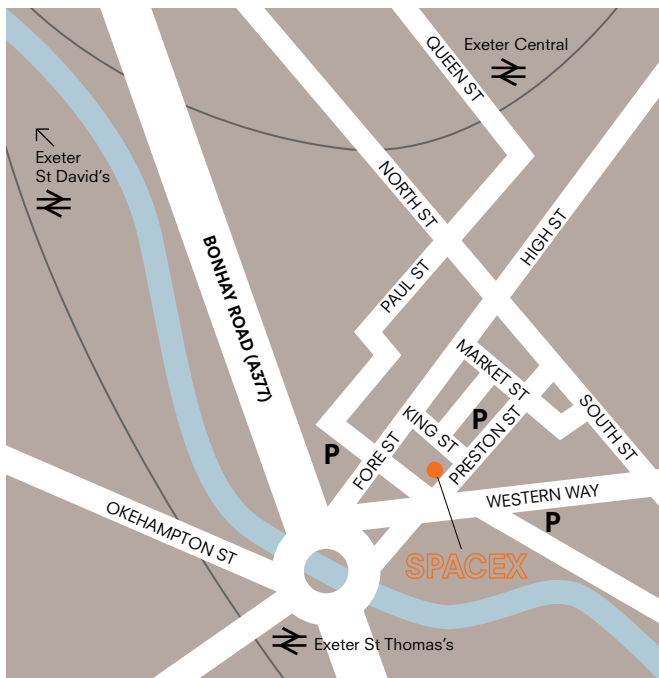
- **Advance booking** is essential - please allow at least one week's notice for a tour and at least a month's notice for an artist-led workshop.
- We recommend that you make a **pre-visit** to the gallery to familiarise yourself with the content. Background reading is available for most exhibitions and teachers can request to use photocopying facilities free of charge.
- **Risk assessment & staff/student ratios** - to help plan your visit and to ensure that things go smoothly please request a copy of the group visits risk-assessment, which you can use as a basis for your own plans. Group leaders are responsible for the behavior of their students throughout the visit. When in the gallery please ensure that your group is supervised at the minimum ratios and that all supervising adults are full briefed.

## HOW TO BOOK

Please telephone or email the Education and Outreach Co-ordinator with the following information:

- **Preferred date and time** of your visit and a range of possible alternatives.
- **Preferred tour/workshop** option.
- **The number of students and accompanying adults** (a ratio of at least 1:10 for students up to year 9 and 1:15 for students in year 10 and above).
- **The age range and ability** of your students and any special educational needs.
- **Your name and contact details** (inc. phone number and email address) and best times to call.
